Following the opening remarks by Vice President Kabashima, General Coordinator Suzuki gave an explanation of the purpose.

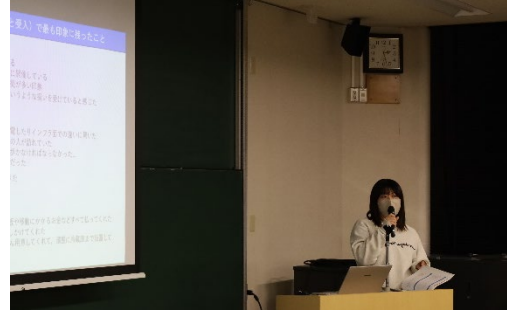


13:00-15:00 Part 1: Post-report on SXIP students

The students presented their impressions (1) the most impressive, (2) what they learned from the group discussion, (3) what they learned about SX, and (4) the good points of the program, the points for improvement, and the message to those who are considering to join SXIP 2024.

In AY2023, we dispatched students to the Indian Institute of Technology Kanpur (India), Panjab University (India), and Newcastle University (Australia) in August, and to Vellore Institute of Technology (India) and Anna University (India) in December. (The dispatch to Griffith University (Australia) was conducted in March, so it was not possible to make it in time for this debriefing session, so it will be conducted separately.)

The students' presentations were praised for their depth of content and skillful preparation of PowerPoint materials. On the other hand, they were encouraged that they should not only absorb what they saw and heard during the dispatch but should also consciously think about what they want to do in the future and suggested that they should acquire knowledge of management such as "5S" in addition to knowledge of science and engineering.
